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NOTE: All applications must be submitted not later than June 1 including ALL official transcripts. Applications are to be written in ink in legible handwriting. All information including income and assets is for the confidential use of the Livingston Lodge #11 William Avery York Scholarship Fund, and is subject to verification from other sources. Do not include applicants name on subsequent pages as judging is conducted on an impartial and blind manner. Identity of applicant is not known to judges.

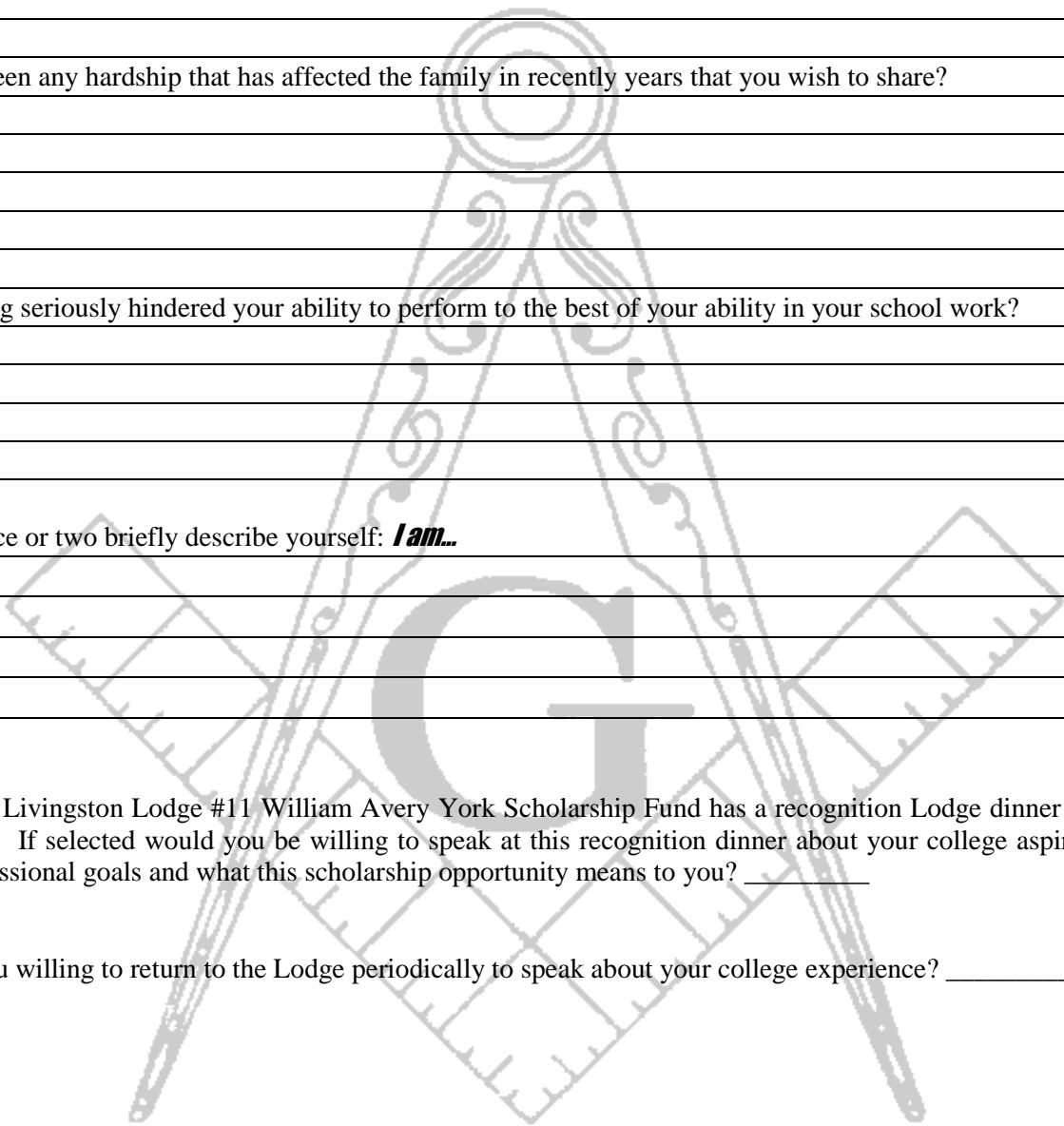
